Émilie Mezerette Deslaurier (* 5 Jun 1795 – † 9 Jan 1872)

1. Name variants: É. or (Marie-) Antoinette Mezerette Deslaurier; Mezerette-Deslorriers
2. Places: La Cour-Pétral in Buzay, St. Catherine in Laval, Mondaye, La Trappe de Soligny
3. Biography: Born in Vilaine la Juhel, she entered the Monastery of St. Catherine in Laval in 1828, made profession on 26 Jun 1829, and departed for the foundation of Mondaye in 1837. From there the community moved to La Cour-Pétral in 1845. É. became the sixth prioress of La Cour-Pétral. She died there. Her remains and those of other sisters were transferred to La Trappe de Soligny in 1990.
