Onofre Clavier (* 5 Jan 1747 – ?)

1. Name variants: Onuphrius, Onofre, François-Xavier (baptismal)

2. Places: Vesoul, Sept-Fons, Rochefort, Saintes, Mathias Le Groing de La Romagère (Saint-Sauvier), Cayenne

3. Biography: O. is one of 13 Rochefort martyrs listed in the DCS. The others are Philip Brandel, François-Xavier Brunel, Paul Charles, Elias Desgardins, Stephen d'Huberte, Macarius d'Incamps, Michael-Joseph Dujonquoi, Matthew Gachet, Joseph-Louis Girod, René Leroy, Florentinus Maillet, and Eligius Richy. O. was born in Vesoul and became a lay brother in Sept-Fons Abbey. For his deportation, see Paul Charles. He was part of the third transport (13 Apr 1794) that reached the prison ship *Deux-Associés*. For background information, see Francis-Xavier Brunel. O. was released at Saintes in Apr 1795, arrested again at Mathias Le Groing de La Romagère in Saint-Sauvier (west of Montluçon) on 26 Nov 1797, deported to Cayenne, and then released on 26 Oct 1801. He was one of the few who survived the deportations; the date of his death is unknown.
