3. Biography: B. was born in Innsbruck. While Paul Gay was the abbot in Stams, he joined the monastery, taking vows on 3 Aug 1634. Three years later, he was sent to Ingolstadt to study, and was prieded on 22 Sep 1640. He served as professor of philosophy in Stams and was named prior on 9 May 1644.
