Martinus Ridt von Kollenberg († 1653)

1. Names: Martin Ridt

2. Places: Wilhering, Engelszell

3. Biography: M. was the son of a patrician family from Augsburg. He entered Wilhering Abbey and later served as administrator of nearby Engelszell, becoming abbot of Engelszell in 1645. He was economically savvy and said to be a wise and practical leader. A visitation report from 1648 highlights his good example and the community's compliance with monastic ideals. Despite wars and the abbey's expansion, M. left behind no debts.
