Peter of Alvastra (14th c.)

1. Name variants: Petrus Olavi, P. Olafson
2. Places: Alvastra (Swedish monastery), Rome
3. Biography: P. is mentioned in the Menologium Cisterciense together with Olav and Tordo. He may be identical with Petrus Olavi, born around 1307 and died in 1390, prior of Alvastra. The Menologium describes him in connection with the dying brother Gerekim's vision of golden letters, seen as a promise of "heavenly joy." P. is associated with Saint Bridget, in whose visions he believed. He visited her in Rome several times.
