## **Tordo of Alvastra** (14th c.)

3. Biography: T., together with Peter and Olaf, is said to have joined the Cistercian Order at Alvastra and to have lived there for a long period. Their names were seen by the dying brother Gerekin written in golden letters, indications that they would experience heavenly joys. Except for this single mention in the *Menologium Cisterciense*, T. is not otherwise known.
