**Petrus Marginet** († ca. 26 Mar 1435)

1. Names: P. of Poblet

2. Places: Poblet (Catalonia)

3. Biography: After contact with a Franciscan monk then at Montblanche, both P. and the mendicant left their communities and lived in an apparently dissolute manner from 1411 to 1413. P. returned to his abbey and was imprisoned, yet released later due to his humility and contrition. He was respected as an example of spiritual atonement. Pope Paul V. decreed to have his remains transferred to the Bernard chapel in 1611, where a magnificent marble monument was erected.
