3. Biography: According to later abbey chronicles, a lay brother from Heiligenkreuz – his name is not known – was murdered by Turks encamped around Vienna in 1529. The rest of the community had fled the monastery in the face of imminent danger. The chronicled accounts claim that when the monks returned, they found the lay brother dead in the cloisters, with his hands and feet cut off.
